*An elegant sparkling Veneto alternative to Prosecco. The volcanic Durello grape grown in the Lessini hills.*

Tinwood Estate Blanc De Blancs, England 2018 £50

*Award winning English sparkling made from 100% Chardonnay grapes.*

*A beautifully balanced, clean wine with heaps of potential.*

Tinwood Estate Rosé, England 2018 £55

*A gorgeous salmon colour with a raspberry and red currant nose, hints of strawberries and cream carry through to a delightfully fruit driven palate.*

Pierre Mignon Grande Réserve Premier Cru Champagne NV £55

*A crisp, well-balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of bready flavours.*

*The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.*

Pierre Mignon Grande Réserve Rosé Champagne NV £65

*A beautifully coloured rosé with delicate red berry fruit on the nose with hints of biscuity complexity.*

*Bright, juicy and creamy on the palate with a core of ripe red fruit and a delicately scented finish.*

Charles Heidsieck Brut Réserve NV £95

*Thanks to the unique blend of reserve wines, this wine offers a complex, elegant, voluptuous nose with a touch of freshly baked brioche, rich toasted notes and sun-drenched fruits. On the palate there is layers of plump red plums and ripe cherries with a finish that unveils notes of vanilla.*

## Fine Wines



### White

Cakebread Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA 2019 £70  
*Grown in the relatively cool climate of the southern Napa Valley, giving an intense minerality to balance the wine's oaky richness and spice. A proportion of grapes from the northern Napa adds creamy, tropical fruit flavours for a balanced, extremely drinkable wine.*

Crystallum 'Ferrum' Chardonnay, Hemel-en-Aarde, South Africa 2021 £75  
*Peter-Michael Finlayson's iconic single vineyard Chardonnay from a vineyard rich in ironstone. This restricts yields to produce a wine of incredible intensity. Hemel-en Aarde is proving itself to be a site for some of the world's best Chardonnays, and this is right up there.*

Meursault Domaine Michelot, Bourgogne, France 2019 £90  
*Domaine Michelot is one of the largest producers in Meursault, with significant vineyard holdings, and they were one of the first to highlight the 'Lieu Dit' on the label for single vineyard bottlings of Village wine. Their classic Meursaults are rich and buttery in style with depth and complexity.*

Condrieu Domaine de la Bonserine, France 2020 £95  
*A beautiful example of this small but distinctive appellation. Condrieu is the spiritual home of the Viognier grape and the wines have incredible richness and intense peach and apricot fruit. The Bonserine Condrieu is focussed with mouthwatering acidity to balance the intensity of fruit. Sustainable agriculture, eschewing the use of pesticides and herbicides, is central to the Domaine's philosophy.*

Puligny-Montrachet, Domaine Borgeot 'Les Grands Champs' France 2019 £120  
*Domaine Borgeot has 23 hectares in the Côte de Beaune including fantastic vineyards in both Puligny and Chassagne. Their approach is sustainable, using organic practices. This is an elegant and strikingly complex and balanced Puligny with bright tangerine and tropical fruit flavours and integrated oak (25% new). The personality of the 2 brothers, Laurent and Pascal, is expressed vividly in their wines.*

### Red

Zinfandel Seghesio, Sonoma County, California 2018 £62  
*A renowned producer of old vine Zinfandels with 125 years of history in Sonoma. A blend of wines from Dry Creek, Alexander Valley and Mendocino. Wild raspberry and blackberry flavours. Powerful but with freshness and balance.*

Beaune le Epenottes Domaine Machard de Gramont, Burgundy 2019 £70  
*A really well made Pinot Noir. Complex savoury notes balanced by bright fruit and supple tannins. All their wines offer really good value for money - words that aren't often associated with Burgundy!*

Cabernet Sauvignon St Supery, Napa Valley California 2017 £105  
*Opulent red hues present in this wine. Aromas of blackberry, black currant and cassis combine with dark cocoa and toasted oak. On the palate, flavours of plum, raspberry and blackberry compote mingle with attractive elements of mocha and toasted barrel maturation. A structured yet elegant Cabernet Sauvignon.*

## Dessert Wine

Côteaux de Layon Baumard, France 2018

£8.75

*This wine is all about pure fruit and mineral freshness with clean flavours and hints of lime. Try as an aperitif to really bring your palate and taste buds to life.*

Sauternes Château Baulac, France 2015

£10.50

*With a delicate nose, this wine offers complex and expressive aromas. The palate is dominated by notes of honey, candied fruit and mango.*

Chambers Rosewood Rutherglen Muscat, Victoria, Australia

£11.00

*Made using traditional methods in oak barrels, this tawny red in colour wine has aromas of raisins, dried fruit and caramel. These aromas carry through to the palate, balanced with fresh acidity. Unctuous and rich yet zesty.*

Greywacke Botrytis Pinot Gris, New Zealand 2018

£14.75

*Kevin Judd's Greywacke is a modern Marlborough icon. A nose of orange marmalade, Tarte tatin and honey. A decadent interpretation of Pinot Gris, richly flavoured with poached quince and dried fruits. A luscious, sweet wine with an elegant structure.*

Poças 2015 Late Bottled Vintage Port, Douro, Portugal

*This sweet style of LBV has rich, soft flavours. Dried fruits and prunes mix with acidity and a structure that gives extra richness.*

Poças 10-year-old Tawny Port, Douro, Portugal

£7.25

*With its proper tawny red colour, this an attractively balanced 10-year-old, with plenty of fresh fruits as well as wood and almonds. Full-bodied and complex, with a long-lasting finish of dried plums.*

Poças 10-year-old White Port, Douro, Portugal

£7.95

*Golden in colour and packed with rich mulled cherries, chocolate and almond-liqueur flavours on a full, fortified body. Its long finish echoes sweetness and nutty maturity.*
